We received a summary of the cultural resources investigations for the Charleston Naval Complex Marine Container Terminal from Brockington and Associates on June 28. The letter summarizes the results from an architectural assessment of two Cold War-era properties near the proposed terminal, the results of an underwater archaeological survey, and the results of cultural resources investigations for the proposed access highways from I-26 to the terminal.

Our office concurs that the proposed Marine Container Terminal will have **no effect** on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places. We appreciate the close consultation with our office on this project.
